The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.25 dated 03.03.2017, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Machhiwara, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 17.04.2017, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that during the integrum, a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and in terms thereof, they are residing happily. Counsel also mentions that a petition bearing Criminal Misc. No. M-25420 of 2017 has been filed for quashing of the instant FIR, on the basis of compromise.

Learned AAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions

from ASI Mohal Lal, Investigating Officer, confirmed this fact.

In view of the facts that the matter stands compromised and consequent thereto, a petition for quashing of the instant FIR has already been filed, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.04.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
