Petitioners seek grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.204 dated 06.03.2017, registered under Sections 186, 279, 307, 332, 336, 353 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 11D of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 at Police Station Sadar Karnal City, District Karnal.

As per allegations in the FIR, 8 calf, one she calf and one buffalo were allegedly recovered from the vehicle. One Danish fled away from the spot leaving the petitioners in the vehicle in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the

alleged recovery of the animals and one empty cartridge 7.65 cannot be attributed to the petitioners in view of the fact that the vehicle and the animals do not belong to any of the petitioner nor any fire arm was recovered from the petitioners.

Petitioners are in custody since 06.03.2017.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh submitted that challan has not been presented so far.

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioners on regular bail, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
