No.3 and 4 for the protection of their civil rights.

Son of petitioner No.1 is an accused in case bearing
FIR No.28 dated 21.03.2017 registered under Section 21 of the
NDPS Act and Sections 307/34 IPC at Police Station Sadar,
Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners alleged that there is
no incriminating material against the petitioners in the aforesaid
case and they have been harassed.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl,
AG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1
to 3.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to
pass, there is no necessity of calling upon reply.

At this juncture, no such opinion can be formed merely on the basis of assertions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, however, respondent No.2 can be obligated to look into the grievance of the petitioners which is statedly pending in the form of representation dated 27.03.2017 before him.
