Prayer in this petition has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.171 dated 23.12.2011 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 325 I.P.C. (added later on) pertaining to Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, the petitioners as well as respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to Illaqa Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Report of the Illaqa Magistrate having Endorsement No.82 dated 07.02.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge,

Hoshiarpur vide his letter No.2598 dated 09.02.2017 has been received.

According to the report of Sub Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.171 is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
