On 19.04.2017, following order was passed by this

Court:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioners intends
to withdraw the petition qua petitioner No.1.
Ordered accordingly.*

*As per allegations in the FIR, petitioner
No.2 gave a lalkara and fist blow to injured
Kulwant Singh, whereas no injury has been
attributed to petitioner No.3.*

Notice of motion qua petitioners No.2 and 3

for 01.06.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioners No.2 and 3 are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 26.04.2017 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that pursuant to aforesaid order, petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined the investigation.

This fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Sushil Kumar.

Learned counsel for the complainant however objects to the aforesaid prayer.

Since, prayer qua petitioner No.1 was withdrawn on 19.04.2017 and petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined the investigation, therefore, order dated 19.04.2017 is hereby made absolute.
