Petitioner-Sabhu @ Ranjit Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.39 dated 04.04.2014, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC, added later on.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with *datar*. He has caused three injuries to the complainant including grievous injury on the head with the help of *datar*.

The weapon is yet to be recovered from the present petitioner

and he is required for custodial interrogation. Otherwise also, in view of the

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nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that grievous injury has been caused on the vital part of the body, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
