This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No.78 dated 04.02.2016, under Section 21C of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sirsa, District Sirsa. Petitioner was arrested on 04.02.2016 and is in jail since then.

According to the prosecution, there was recovery of 45 bottles of rexcof and only 2 bottles were sent for FSL examination. Keeping in view the quantity of bottles and the fact that samples of only 2 bottles were sent for FSL examination, the petitioner is entitled to bail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence, threaten or exercise any influence on the prosecution witnesses.
