This order be read in this case as well as in CWP No. 13368 of 2003.

Respondent-workman was ordered by the Labour Court to be reinstated with continuity of service and 30% back wages. The management filed the present writ petition. It may be observed here that the workman also filed CWP No. 13368 of 2003 claiming full back wages.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that just to compromise the matter since the respondent-workman has already been taken back in service and regularised in 2014, the Management is prepared to pay 20% back wages instead of 30%.

Respondent-workman is present in person. He has made a statement that this offer of 20% back wages instead of 30% is acceptable to him.

Let the Management calculate the arrears and pay the same to respondent-workman in its office within three weeks from today. In case of any clarification the parties may approach us again.

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In view of the above, both the writ petitions have been rendered infructuous and stand disposed of as such.
