Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.217 dated 07.08.2016, under Sections 392/394/397 and 34 of IPC Act, registered at Police Station DLF Phase-1, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned State counsel submits that one more case is pending against the petitioner under Section 148/149/341/452 and 106 IPC.

In my opinion, since the material witness has been turned hostile, there is no point to detain him in jail under trial.

Hence, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate / Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall attend the police station concerned where he resides on every Monday, Wednesday and Sunday between 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM every week. Petitioner shall file an undertaking before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
