Petitioner-Rajinder Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.649 dated 12.11.2016, registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 279, 304 and 304-A IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, firstly the FIR was registered under Sections 279 and 304-A IPC. However, during investigation on getting CCTV footage, it was found that the present

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petitioner pushed deceased-Lalit towards the moving truck, due to which he suffered injuries and died. Thereafter, Section 304 IPC was added in the present case.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence as well as active role of the present petitioner in the commission of offence and the case being at a preliminary stage, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
