Prayer in this petition has been made for quashing of the cross version i.e. D.D.R. No.26(A) registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 34 of the Indian Penal Code in F.I.R. No.42 dated 30.05.2012 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149 I.P.C. and Section 326 I.P.C. (added later on) pertaining to Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, the petitioners as well as respondents No.2 and 3 were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to Illaqa Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Report of the Illaqa Magistrate having Endorsement No.40 dated 12.06.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge,

Hoshiarpur vide his letter No.13023 dated 17.06.2017 has been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hoshiarpur, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid D.D.R. No.26(A) is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
