Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record fresh passport size photographs of the petitioners to reveal their identity which is not discernible from the photographs earlier placed on the file.

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Jasjeet Dhaliwal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

Mr. Harshit Jain, Advocate has put in appearance on his own and filed his *vakalatnama* on behalf of private respondents No.4 and 6/father as well as brother of petitioner No.1, which is taken on record and though has tried to oppose the relationship of the petitioners but this Court is only granting protection which is a fundamental right under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

Upon hearing arguments at length for some time and on perusal

of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) within the framework of law.

Meanwhile, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the Police by the petitioners they will act into it expeditiously in accordance with law.
