The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 205, dated 13.11.2014, under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station E-Division, Amritsar.

As per the allegations in the FIR, 300 grams of Lorazepam is stated to have been recovered from the petitioner, which is above the threshold of 250 grams as commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel contends that all the witnesses have been examined and the matter is now listed on 28.08.2017 before the trial Court for arguments.

Therefore, as the recovery effected from the petitioner is above the threshold of commercial quantity and the trial has almost concluded, I do not find any merit in the instant petition, which stands dismissed.
