Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has a record of commission of similar offences, so also under the NDPS Act. The present offences under Sections 457, 380 IPC are again in relation to theft of bicycles. The concession of grant of anticipatory bail cannot be extended to the petitioner in the light of criminal antecedents.

In that view of the matter, this petition stands dismissed. Interim order dated 19.04.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner also stands vacated.
