This petition for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner has been filed in criminal case bearing FIR No.18 dated 06.02.2017 registered under Section 20/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Rajound, District Kaithal. The petitioner was arrested on 08.02.2017 and is in jail since then.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was found in possession of 1.66 Kgs. of Sulpha (charas) which is above the commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel has stated that no other case is stated to be pending against the petitioner.

Trial will take its own time, hence no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Ashwani Sharma @ Soni be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court / CJM / Duty Magistrate concerned.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
