**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jagmal Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.14 dated 09.01.2017 at Police Station Model Town, District Rewari under Sections 420/200/181 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 19.04.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh from Police Station Model Town, District Rewari who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.04.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.

During the course of arguments, it has come to the notice of this Court and as is admitted by the two sides that a number of matters of similar nature arising out of the HUDA plots are pending before different Benches of this Court. Registrar (Judicial) is directed to get the details of all these cases which are of similar nature and after obtaining necessary permission from Hon'ble the Chief Justice, shall ensure that the same are listed before one and the same Bench so as to avoid expression of divergent opinions.
