Fresh Vakalatnama on behalf of the petitioner, superseding the earlier counsel with no objection has been filed, which is taken on record.

Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.18 dated 05.04.2013 registered under Sections 323 and 324 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise dated 18.03.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 26.04.2016 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of fifteen days, for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar on 09.05.2016 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter No.225-AG dated 27.07.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide letter No.2028G/JRK dated 28.07.2016.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, the parties have got effected compromised between them. The same is genuine one and is voluntarily without any pressure, duress or any undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.18 is quashed qua the petitioner, subject to depositing costs of ₹10,000/- by the petitioner with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
