TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.107 dated 02.04.2016, under Sections 302/201/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of one Satbir Singh who had discovered a dead body of an unknown person in a half burnt condition lying in the bushes adjoining his fields.

The deceased was identified as Jitender son of Ramji Lal.

During the course of investigation, Dharmender @ Dharma was arrested on 06.04.2016. Even Ashok Kumar, Parveen and Deepak i.e. present petitioner have been arrested thereafter.

As per prosecution version, the disclosure statements of co-accused point out the complicity of the present petitioner in the alleged crime.

Material witnesses in the case are yet to be examined before the trial Court.

Under such circumstances, this Court would not be inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail at this stage.

Petition is, accordingly, disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court afresh after the deposition of material witnesses is concluded.
