Mr. Balraj Gujjar, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of the complainant and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has pointed to the report of the SHO (Annexure P-1) stating therein that as per the inquiry conducted at the Patel Uch Prathmic Vidhyala, Tijara (Rajasthan), no certificate was issued by that school in respect of the petitioner having passed Class VIII from there.

In view of the above, I see no reason to continue with the interim order dated 20.04.2017, passed in favour of the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed and the interim order dated 20.04.2017 stands vacated.

Even while dismissing the petition, it must be noticed here that very strangely, as per the order 06.09.2016 (Annexure P-3), shown to be passed by the

Deputy Commissioner, Mewat, he has stated that nothing was found against the

petitioner by the police in Tijara, whereas actually learned State counsel submits that the position is that all that the Tijara police had stated was, that they had no jurisdiction.

The Deputy Commissioner concerned would be well advised to at least check the factual position before he passes an order.
