This is the second petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.190 dated 11.12.2015 under sections 406, 420 I.P.C (offence under sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C were added later on) and section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station, Division No.7, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

During the course of arguments it stands conceded that the petitioner having evaded the process of law was declared a Proclaimed Offender by the competent court on 16.4.2016.

The instant petition has been filed on 17.4.2017.

The factum of the petitioner having already been declared a Proclaimed Offender has been concealed in the instant petition. There is not even a single averment to such effect.

Conduct of the petitioner disentitles her from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
