Petitioner-Vinod has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.92 dated 03.02.2017, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, under Sections 20, 25 and 27-A of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that *ganja patti* weighing 33 kg. 400 grams was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Now the report of FSL has been received and as per the same, the articles/samples

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have been stated to be *Ganja*. The aforesaid recovery falls in commercial quantity. Section 37 of the NDPS Act, 1985 bars the benefit of bail to the accused in case of commercial quantity.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the aforesaid recovery falls under commercial quantity, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
