Petitioner-Jyotti @ Jagjiwanjyot Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.10 dated 20.02.2017, registered at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala, under Sections 307, 336, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been

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registered on the statement of Manpreet Kaur with the main allegations that after taking meals at night, she slept in her in-laws house. At about, 11.33 P.M., she heard gun-shots outside her house. She and her sister-in-law (Nanand) came out and saw that many persons were abusing her husband and firing in air towards their house. It is a case of no injury.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 20.04.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 20.04.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
