The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.688 dated 10.08.2016 registered under Sections 302 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the evidence against the petitioner is in the form of disclosure statement by the co-accused based on which recovery of knife was made. It is disclosed that the petitioner had killed the deceased by means of knife which was ultimately recovered from him. There is no other evidence according to the prosecution also.

Perusal of the FIR shows that the informant came to know about the incident. In that view of the matter, petition for bail is allowed.

Petitioner-Ashok is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall not temper with the prosecution evidence and shall not threaten the prosecution witnesses.
