Upon notice issued, the petitioner is stated to have joined the investigation. However, as per learned State counsel, though no other criminal case has so far have been registered against him, he allegedly is involved in the sale and purchase of stolen vehicles to different persons in Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh and allegedly, he is also the person who changes the engine and chassis numbers on stolen vehicles.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, since the petitioner is stated to be one of the persons who is, on a regular basis suspected of indulging in the aforesaid activity, I see no reason to continue with the bail granted on 20.04.2017.

The petition is therefore, dismissed.

However, any application filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. before the trial Court would be decided on its on merits, as expeditiously as possible.
