Upon notice issued in this petition in which the petitioners are seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents no.5 to 9, as they have married each other stated to be against the will of the said respondents, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Madan Lal, submits that the statements of respondents no.5, 6, 7 and 9 have been recorded at Police Station Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa, to the effect that the said respondents have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners to each other and as such, the petitioners have no threat from the said respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners no longer wish to reside in the Protection Home, Sector-19, Chandigarh, where they had been sent vide an order of this Court dated 20.04.2017, as the petitioners had stated that they had even been fired upon at the house of petitioner no.1, in respect of which an FIR had also been registered.

However, today on a specific question put to the petitioners, as

to whether they are still apprehending any threat, petitioner no.2 has replied in the negative and stated that the matter has been settled between them and respondents no.5 to 9.

The petitioners are, therefore, directed to be released from the Protection Home, Sector-19, Chandigarh, immediately.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, though with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to otherwise ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners continue to be protected, within the four corners of law.

On request of Ms. Aashima Mor, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, a copy of this order be given to the learned counsel for the petitioners under signatures of the Special Secretary of the Bench, so that the petitioners may be got released from the Protection Home.
