FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Allegations against the petitioner Poonam in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.7 dated 06.01.2017 registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh under Sections 306/34 IPC, are that she was married to the deceased Anand son of the complainant Sharbati Devi and on account of the matrimonial disaccord has led to filing of innumerable criminal cases by the wife which led the deceased going under depression and ultimately on 05.01.2017 he committed suicide.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that no specific role is attributed to the petitioner and thus no element of abetment to suicide is made out against her.

Learned State counsel with all fairness has conceded at the bar that as per the prosecution story neither any specific role nor any element of abetment to suicide is there against the petitioner though he has sought to oppose bail on the grounds that it is the evidence which will ultimately nail the petitioner as the circumstances spelled could be rallying upon against her.

Appreciating the submissions, as per the own initial stand of the State and perusal of the FIR nowhere any specific role has been attributed to the petitioner. Keeping in view the long drawn legal battle between the deceased and the petitioner prior to the death keeps the Court on its guard to any false implication. The petitioner is behind the bars and the investigations and trial will take a long time to conclude and the culpability if any shall be determined at the time of trial, impels this Court to allow the prayer. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
