ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.289, dated 02.06.2016, under Sections 365, 395 & 379-B of IPC (Section 397 added later on), registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR, wherein it is stated that 06 persons had stopped the complainant and his friend and had beaten them up. He further states that the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 01 month since the date of his arrest on 06.09.2016. He also contends that the complainant and the injured have fully recovered from the injuries.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Umed Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been presented and 05 out of 19 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 01 month and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time as 14 prosecution witnesses remained to be examined, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Sonu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
