Affidavit of Chanan Singh filed by learned counsel for the respondent-complainant today in Court, is taken on record.

Rule. Heard forthwith with the consent of learned counsel for the rival parties.

In a private complaint case No.152A-1 of 11.06.2008, the accused persons, namely the petitioners were discharged vide the order dated 07.09.2015 (Annexure P-3) by the trial Court. However, the said order was reversed by the revisional Court vide order dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) as a result, the petitioners are required to face the proceedings after remand by the revisional Court.

Now, today, respondent-Complainant Chanan Singh along with Mr. Tarun Dhatta, Advocate is present in person before this Court and the learned counsel for the respondent-complainant upon

instructions, makes a statement that the impugned order dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) be set aside by consent as petitioners and the complainant are neighbours and hereafter, they want to live in peace and harmony.

Looking to the fact that the case in question was a complaint case, by consent, even by the respondent-complainant who is present in Court today through his Counsel, the impugned order dated 14.03.2017 deserves to be quashed and set aside. In the result, following order is passed:-

**ORDER**

- (i) CRM-M-13180 of 2017 is allowed;
- (ii) Impugned order dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) is quashed and set aside;
- (iii) Consequently criminal compliant case No.152A-1 of 11.06.2008 is also quashed.
