The instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents for not harassing the petitioners as they have been repeatedly called to the police station and at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7.

While issuing notice of motion on 27.04.2016, this Court had taken notice of the contention raised by counsel that there was a money dispute between the petitioners and the private respondents and the police officials at the behest of the private respondents were repeatedly summoning the petitioners and as such they were being harassed.

In response to the petition, a joint reply on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 has been placed on record. Copy already stands furnished to counsel for the petitioners. In para 3 of the reply, it has been stated that the petitioners as also private respondents have levelled allegations against each other. The petitioners have not been able to produce any witness/material to substantiate that the private respondents

stand taken is that even the private respondents could not produce any document to establish that they had ever advanced any money to the present petitioners.

The reply filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Mansa records that the applications filed by both the parties i.e. petitioners herein as also the private respondents were accordingly consigned.

In the light of stand taken on behalf of the State in the reply duly placed on record, no directions are required to be passed in the instant petition. The same is disposed of.
