This petition has been filed for issuing directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to protect the lives, liberty and property of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that respondent No.4 is the real son whereas respondent No.5 is the daughter-in-law of the petitioners. The said respondent Nos.4 and 5 are pressurizing the petitioners to transfer the house and flour mill in their name. The respondent Nos.4 and 5 are also denying to provide any food to them. The petitioners are stated to be aged 68 and 69 years, respectively.

The petitioners have filed the representation (Annexure P-3) dated 27.10.2016 to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana Rural seeking protection of their lives, liberty and property from respondents No.4 and 5.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.R.P.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Copy of the petition is supplied to learned State counsel in the Court.

This petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioners as per law and to provide the necessary protection to them, if any case for the same is made out during the enquiry of this representation. Needful be done within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
