A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

The matter was heard yesterday. Today, Mr. Anurag Jain makes a request that the petition be allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to raise all the points during trial. He further submits that the petitioner belongs to Yamuna Nagar, which is at a distance of 250 kilometers from Hisar, therefore, he should be granted personal exemption. In my opinion, until the attendance of the petitioner on every date of hearing is most essential, there is no need to have attendance of the petitioner before the trial court on every date of hearing. In that view of the matter, the trial court shall grant personal exemption to the petitioner from appearance unless it is necessary to have his presence for a particular purpose.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
