Learned counsel for the appellant, at the very outset, fairly states that despite having been made repeated efforts on his part, no instructions are being passed on to him by the appellant, because of which he is unable to assist the court.

It is also a matter of record that respondents No.1, 2 and 4 have since died. Respondent No.3 could not be served for want of complete address. Similarly, respondent No.6 has also not been served. No steps were ever taken on behalf of the appellant to effect service on the unserved respondents or to bring on record legal representatives of respondents No.1, 2 and 4. It seems that appellant is no more interested in pursuing the present appeal.

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In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the appellant, instant appeal is dismissed for non prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the appellant to get the appeal revived within a period of three months from today, if necessity arises.
