Pursuant to the order dated 17.01.2017 issuing notice to the respondents, as per the report of the Registry, notice could not be issued as no process fee has been filed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Jasbir Singh, submits that petitioner no.2 approached the SHO, Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib (respondent no.3), seeking protection, 'armed' with a copy of the petition, but thereafter, the statements of the petitioners were recorded that they no longer require protection.

That would seem to be the case also from the fact that no process fee was filed in this case.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to continue to ensure that the lives and liberty of the

petitioners are continued to be protected, within the four corners of law.
