Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.57 dated 15.11.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148, 149 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code pertaining to Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise dated 31.03.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, the petitioners were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 27.04.2017 and direction was issued to the Magistrate to summon respondents No.2 and 3 and record statements of the parties with regard to the compromise with a further direction to the Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur vide

letter No.239 dated 22.05.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and

Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide letter No.8788/RKT dated 23.05.2017 has been received.

According to the report of the Magistrate, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure, undue influence or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, F.I.R. No.57 dated 15.11.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148, 149 and 326 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
