The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in Criminal Complaint No. 44 dated 06.08.2005 under Sections 406, 498-A and 120-B of the IPC titled as ***Manjit Kaur vs. Jaswant Singh and ors.***

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has been appearing regularly before the trial Court which fact is not disputed by the counsel for the respondent herein.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has been appearing regularly before the trial Court, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and order dated 22.04.2014, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid

down in Section 438, Sub Section (2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
