Petitioner-Deepak @ Pellu has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.190 dated 20.11.2016, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 201, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and the complainant also appeared through his counsel.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has been named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with hockey stick and has caused simple injury on the left thigh of the complainant-Gagandeep @ Gaggi.

The petitioner is not the main accused. Moreover, the petitioner has been in custody since 22.11.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
