This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 52 dated 7.5.2012 under Sections 419/420/467/468/469/471 IPC registered at Police Station City Jagron.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the order dated 24.4.2017, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bikramjeet Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the said fact, present petition is allowed and the order passed by this Court dated 24.4.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions mentioned below, as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C :-

1. He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and
3. He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
