This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 21.04.2017 the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for getting their statements recorded with regard to compromise.

However, the parties did not comply with the order.

Vide order dated 25.05.2017 an opportunity was further granted to the parties to record their statements. Despite availing a number of opportunities the parties did not appear before the competent Court.

Now, CRM No.37640 of 2017 has been filed seeking further time for recording the statements.

It appears that either the compromise has collapsed or the parties have lost interest in the matter.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has instructions to withdraw the present petition.
