Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.21 dated 23.02.2016 for the offence under Sections 498-A, 506, IPC (Section 406 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 28.04.2016, the anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners and during the pendency of the petition, a settlement/agreement was arrived at between the parties on 05.09.2016 with the assistance of Mr. Sohan Singh Sivia, Mediator. Petitioners are parents-in-law of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has informed that as per settlement/agreement dated 05.09.2016, first motion statements have been recorded and ₹ 4 lakhs has already been paid to the complainant. The

balance amount will be given on the date of decree of divorce.

Keeping in view of the above fact, the order dated 28.04.2016
passed by this Court, is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
