The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners on account of having voiced an apprehension and threat to the same as they had entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders.

Notice of motion was issued in the case on 17.01.2017.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar apprises the Court that statements of both the petitioners have since been recorded and wherein they have stated that they are staying happily together and they do not apprehend any threat to their life and liberty.

This also perhaps explains the non-appearance of the counsel for the petitioners.

No further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
