By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 21.03.2017, registered under Section 5/13 (2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, at Police Station Pinangwan, District Mewat.

On 20.04.2017, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was neither arrested from the spot nor is he involved in any other FIR.

Notice of motion for 26.05.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a

police officer as and when required;
2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3.That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 20.04.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, he is involved in other 02 FIRs wherein he has been admitted to bail.

Considering the fact that recovery stands effected; petitioner is already on bail in other FIRs, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.04.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
