The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.37 dated 09.02.2016, registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, Distt. Faridabad.

Heard.

This is the second bail petition preferred by the petitioner. The earlier petition bearing CRM-M-42541-2016 was dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the matter stands posted for arguments, whereas, learned counsel for the petitioner

states that the matter is slated for recording of defence evidence.

Without going into the merits of the submissions raised by learned counsel for the parties, the fact remains that the trial is at the fag end.

In the circumstances, the instant petition is dismissed.

However, the trial Court is now directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably, within a period of eight weeks from the next date of hearing before it.
