The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in complaint case No.6 dated 18.02.2016 registered under Section 3(X) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes Act and Sections 323, 506 & 34 IPC pending before learned JMIC, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties including counsel for the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposed the petition for grant of anticipatory bail and prayed for vacating the interim order.
