Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of the cross case registered vide D.D.R. No.35 dated 10.09.2015 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 I.P.C. in case F.I.R. No.58 dated 10.09.2015 under Sections 452, 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Jhander, District Amritsar (Rural) on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, the petitioners as well as respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Report of the Illaqa Magistrate having Endorsement No.46 dated 25.05.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide his letter No.4881-R dated 30.05.2017 has been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ajnala, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid D.D.R. No.35 is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
