The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.206 dated 17.07.2015, under Sections 498-A, 323, 406 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Dadri City, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 24.04.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of SDJM, Charkhi Dadri, dated 10.05.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which

indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.206 dated 17.07.2015, under Sections 498-A, 323, 406 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Dadri City, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
