The petitioner was re-arrested in FIR No.77 dated 28.06.2014 registered under Sections 15/18 of the Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala, upon his surrender on 09.03.2017 and is in jail since then and since the trial has not been commenced.

The challan in this case was filed on 31.08.2015. But the petitioner had failed to appear before the trial Court and as such the bail that was granted to him was cancelled.

Learned State counsel fairly states, on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, that there is no other case is pending against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner would be entitled to bail pending trial.
