“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in a complaint case under Sections 193, 195,, 196, 211, 220, 345, 365, 34 and 120-B I.P.C., the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail. The petitioner was appearing before the trial Court regularly. During the intervening period, one FIR No. 31 was registered on 15.03.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 499, 500 and 120-B I.P.C. and under Section 72 of the Information and Technology Act, at Police Station Khizrabad, District Yamuna Nagar. Feeling reasonable apprehension of his arrest, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on the date fixed, i.e.

03.04.2017. Resultantly, his bail was cancelled. In the aforesaid State case, the petitioner was ultimately granted interim bail by the High Court vide order dated 14.04.2017 in CRM-M No. 12604 of 2017.

Notice of motion for 17.05.2017.

It has been informed that 21.04.2017 is the date fixed before the trial Court in the complaint case.

Let the petitioner appear before the trial Court on the date fixed, i.e. 21.04.2017. In the event of his appearance before the trial Court, he shall be granted interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court on 21.04.2017 and has been granted interim bail by the trial Court.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel duly assisted by learned counsel for the complainant.

Since the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail in the complaint case and he could not appear on account of his involvement in FIR No.31 dated 15.03.2017, therefore, I deem it appropriate to make the order dated 20.04.2017 absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on appearing before the trial Court on each and every date.
