ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.20 dated 25.03.2017 under Sections 451/295/448/511/506/148/149 registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a dispute with regard to management of Gurudwara in village Balewal. He further states that only simple injuries are alleged to have been caused in the incident, which were also suffered by some members of the petitioners' party.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 28.04.2017, had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on

ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurpal Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 28.04.2017 the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 28.04.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
