In the instant petition, the petitioner has questioned the validity of the order dated 13.10.1993 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.4 by which the petitioner has been dismissed from service by holding an ex-parte inquiry and orders dated 10.5.1995 (Annexure P-10) and order dated 19.9.1995 (Annexure P-11) by which the appeal and revision petition filed by the petitioner have been rejected.

During the pendency of this petition on 3.3.1997, revisional authority-Director General of Police passed an order while annulling the order of dismissal and the petitioner stands reinstated in service w.e.f. 13.10.1993 while passing such order, the petitioner has been denied certain service benefits like backwages and treating the intervening period as extraordinary leave (without leave).

The petitioner has not questioned the validity of order dated 3.3.1997 by which certain service benefits have been taken away. On the other hand, he has not obeyed order dated 3.3.1997 i.e. reporting for duty. Even to this day, he has not reported so as to contend that there is a stay of order dated 3.3.1997 or official respondents have prohibited him in

reporting for duty. At the best, the petitioner is entitled for service rendered for the period from the date of appointment till 3.3.1997. In this regard, the petitioner is directed to approach the respondents and the respondents are directed to consider the same within a reasonable period from the date of receipt of such application or representation from the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of.
