Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.0997 dated 27.10.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Jind City, vide order dated 18.01.2017 passed by this Court.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 18.01.2017.

The dispute relates to the transfer of money from one society to the other. The Registrar, Firms & Societies, Jind has also recorded the cancellation of the society. The appeal before the Registrar General of Societies, Haryana at Chandigarh is pending.

In that view of the matter, the order dated 18.01.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, with liberty in favour of the State as well as of the complainant to apply for recall of this order in the event of the Registrar General or Higher authority decides against the petitioner.
